- ▶ Two hard copies and one soft copy (in CD/DVD) of the full length paper must be submitted at the time of presentation of the research paper.
- ▶ Medium of Abstract and full paper will be Sanskrit /English/ Hindi.
- ▶ The Name, Designation, Email Id and Contact Number of the author should clearly be written in the Abstract and in the title page of the paper.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University was established by an Act of the Assam State Legislative Assembly in 2011. Kumar Bhaskar Varma, a great monarch of Assam (7th Century AD), was a patron of Sanskrit studies and during his rule Vedic culture and Sanskrit studies came to flourish in Assam. The University has adopted a Kalidasean line *Sarasvatī Śrūtimahatām Mahīyatām* (May the sayings of the wise be glorified) as its motto. The Executive Council has approved different degree, diploma and certificate programmes under the School of Sanskrit Studies, the School of Ancient Studies and the School of Humanities. M.A. in Sanskrit (Sahitya, Vedic Studies), Education, Political Science, Philosophy, Assamese and Integrated M.A. in Sanskrit courses have been introduced by the University under these three different Schools. Besides, there is a certificate course in Communicative Sanskrit which is compulsory for the students belonging to disciplines other than Sanskrit.

Location:

The University campus is situated at village Namati in the district of Nalbari, Assam, which is at a distance of 3.3km from the 31 National Highway. The nearest airport is Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport at Borjhar, Guwahati and railway station is Nalbari which are at a distance of about 70km and 5km respectively from the University Campus.



ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The Vedas are the sole vehicle of Indian culture, literature, tradition and society. Indian tradition holds the Vedas in high esteem especially due to sacrificial rituals and spiritual knowledge incorporated therein. Huge instances of Mantras containing elements pertaining to human values relevant for all times are there in Samhitās, Brāhmaṇas, Āraṇyakas and Upaniṣads. Universal brotherhood, human welfare and universal prosperity are some of ingredients constituting the Vedas. The people in the Vedic age realised that to lead a safe, healthy and disciplined life, man and even other animals also need a healthy environment. In the Ṛgveda, we get several hymns where the prayers have been uttered for the protection of the family members along with their pets and belongings. From this, it is clear that Vedic people were very much aware of a sound ecology. The proposed seminar is aimed at highlighting the entire Vedic literature as the source of oriental knowledge system.
