

Perspective Plan of the University: (2016-2021)

Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient University has witnessed visible growth in the past eight years in areas of basic academic initiatives and infrastructural development. To further accelerate growth, the University initiated a five-year perspective plan (2016-2021).

The goals of the *five-year perspective plan* (2016-2021) are as follows:

1. To achieve global excellence in academics and encourage research in Ancient and Sanskrit based knowledge system under M. Phil and Ph.D. programmes in all departments. The University also plans to introduce Traditional Degrees of *Shastri* (equivalent to B.A), *Acharya* (equivalent to M.A.) and *Vidya Varidhi* (equivalent to Ph.D.) under the School of Ancient Studies.
2. To open Post Graduate Diploma in Gandhian Studies (PGDGS) Programme as part of its effort on human values and to conduct different extension programmes of social relevance under it.
3. To introduce certificate courses on Yogic Science, Yoga Therapy, Sasvaravedapath, *Karmakanda Prashikshanam* and Manuscript Studies.
4. To introduce Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) across all programmes offered by the University.
5. To augment infrastructural facilities including construction of girls' and boys' hostel, academic building, auditorium, *Yajnashala*, sports complex and quarters for teaching as well as non-teaching staff.
6. To avail the services of permanent police outpost, health-care centre, bus and ATM at the University.
7. To reform and re-organize the programme of Traditional Studies (*Tol* education).
8. To facilitate a student-centric development through *Chatra Sansad*, students' feedback system, grievance redressal mechanism.
