Important Notes:

- Fee waiver scheme of Govt. of Assam will only be applicable candidates who apply through SAMARTH portal.
- All applicants must generate their Unique ID in the Website of the Director of Higher Education, Assam before admission.
- The admission fees to be paid at the time of admission shall be received only through **debit card/UPI** payment only.
- The admission will be done on the university premise only.
- Candidates are asked to bring the following documents in original along with self attested photocopies of all the documents during the time of admission.
 - i) Acknowledgement of Online application.
 - ii) Acknowledgement of Unique Id
 - iii) HSLC Admit card, Mark sheet and Certificate
 - iv) HSSLC Mark sheet and Certificate
 - v) PRC/Voter ID (Candidates' or parents')/Domicile Certificate
 - vi) Other qualification mark sheet/ certificate (if any)
 - vii) Caste/Category certificate (if applicable)
 - viii) Extra-curricular certificate/s (if any)
 - ix) Income Certificate issued by the Circle Officer (if applicable)
 - x) PWD (person with disability/specially abled category) certificate as applicable.
- Existing provision of reservation shall be applicable as per Assam Govt. rule.
- Caste certificate must be issued by the competent authority under the Government of Assam.
- UR-Economically Weaker Section (UR-EWS): The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. EWS seats will be based on intake capacity of each department.
- **Person with Disability (PwD):** There is a provision of 3% reserved seats for PwD candidates as per the Universityrules. Visually Impaired and/ or Hearing Impaired and / or Orthopedically Handicapped (on horizontal reservation basis) candidates, have to submit a self-attested copy of Disability Certificate issued by the District Chief Medical Officer/Medical Board. The disability benefits will be given to those candidates only who have at least 40% physical impairments. The percentage of disability should be mentioned in the certificate. The physical disability may be verified by a medical practitioner when the same will be possible.
- Extra Curricular Activities: For admission against the quota allotted for extra-curricular activities like Cultural, Sports, NCC, Scouts & Guides, the candidates must furnish the requisite documents.

1(One) Percent of Seat may be offered by the concerned Department for admission to UG/PG courses to students within intake capacity who have shown extraordinary proficiency in extracurricular activities in the last three years. Any sport/event organized by an association must be recognized by and affiliated to the national body for that sport/event.
