1.1 TITLE :

THIS DOCUMENT SHALL BE CALLED THE
"ACADEMIC REGULATIONS OF KUMAR BHASKAR VARMA SANSKRIT
AND ANCIENT STUDIES UNIVERSITY ON GRADING SYSTEM"

1.2 Date Of Enforcement: These regulations shall come into force with effect from the academic session 2017-2018

1.3 Scope of application: these regulations shall apply to students admitted to the degree/diploma certificate programmes in the university.

1.4 Regulations for extra-ordinary situation: Registrar/Controller of Examinations will be the sole decision maker in the matters arising out of any extra ordinary situation which is not covered by these regulations.

2.1 Operational definitions :

2.1.1 Academic year: two consecutive (one odd + one even) semesters from one academic year.

2.1.2 Semester: A semester shall be of minimum 65 working days (13 weeks) excluding the days required for holding examinations.

2.1.3. Course: A course is usually consists of a paper in a programme. A course may be designed to comprise lectures/tutorials/laboratory works/field work/outreach activities/project work/viva/seminars/working papers/home assignments/presentations/group discussions/book review etc.

2.1.4. Credit: Credit is a measuring unit which determines the number of hours of instructions required per week per semester.

2.1.5. Credit value: One credit is equivalent to one hour of teaching (lecture or tutorials) or two hours of laboratory work/field work per week or four hour of research every week

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2.1.7. **Credit Requirement**:- An academic programme will have to offer minimum 80 and maximum 96 credits for 2 year post graduate programme. However the minimum credit for a semester must not be less than 20.

2.1.8. **Programme**:- A calculated programme leading to and of a degree, diploma or certificate.

2.1.9. **Cumulative Grade point Average (CGPA)**:- It is a measure of overall cumulative performance of a student over all semesters. The CPGA is the ratio of total credit points secured by a student in various courses in all semesters and the sum of the total credits of all courses in all the semesters. It is expressed up to two decimal places.

2.1.10. **Semester grade point average (SGPA)**:- It is a measure of performance of work done in a semester. It is ratio of total credit points secured by a student in various courses registered in a semester and all the total course credits taken during that semester. It shall be expressed up to two decimal places.

2.1.11. **Grade point**:- it is a numerical weight allotted to each letter grade on a 10-point scale.

2.1.12. **Letter Grade**:- It is an Index of the performance of students in a said course. Grades are denoted by letters O, A, A⁺, B⁺, B, P and F.

3.1 This university will adopt Absolute Grading method for awarding different grade, to student. Under the absolute grading, the marks are converted to grade based or pre-determined class intervals.

3.1.2. This university recommends the following chart of class intervals for award of grades for post graduate programmes.

(a) Calculation of SGPA

$$SGP = \frac{210}{24} = 8.75$$

SGPA has been calculated by the use of the following formula

$$SGPA (S) = \frac{\sum (C_i X G_i)}{\sum C_i}$$

Here C_i is the number of credits of each course and G_i is the grade point scored by a student in each.

 CGPA &= \frac{24 \times 8.75 + 24 \times 8 + 24 \times 6.5 + 24 \times 8.2}{96 \text{ (Total Credits)}} \\
 &= \frac{210 + 192 + 156 + 196.8}{96} \\
 &= \frac{754.8}{96} = 7.86
 \end{aligned}$$

CGPA 7.86 means 78.6% n(7.86x10)

The CGPA has been calculated by the use of the following format-

$$CGPA = \frac{\sum (C_i X S_i)}{\sum C_i}$$

where S_i is the SGPA of each semester and C_i is the total number of credits in that

An Undergraduate programme having 3 years duration will have to offer minimum 120 credits.




$$\begin{aligned} \text{CGPA} &= \frac{20 \times 7.4 + 20 \times 7.8 + 20 \times 5.6 + 20 \times 6.9 + 20 \times 8 + 20 \times 5.2}{120} \\ &= \frac{148 + 156 + 112 + 138 + 160 + 102}{120} \\ &= \frac{818}{120} \\ &= 6.81 \end{aligned}$$

It means $(6.81 \times 10) = 68.1\%$

(c) The SGPA and CGPA shall be rounded of to 2 decimal points and reported in the transcripts.
