**KBVSAS UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS ON INTEGRATED M.A. IN SANSKRIT PROGRAMME**

(Approved by Executive Council, Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University  
dated -1/1/2022)

**1. SHORT TITLE, APPLICATION AND COMMENCEMENT:**

- 1.1. These Regulations may be called the "KBVSAS University Regulations on implementation of Integrated M.A. in Sanskrit programme".
- 1.2 These shall apply in connection with the admission into regular course in IMS programme.
- 1.3. These shall come into force from the date of notification

**2. ALLOTMENT**

**2.1. Allotment**

The maximum allotment of seat for admission into 1<sup>st</sup> semester is **40** on the basis of merit in all categories. The "Admission Committee" will make the arrangement of admission process of the programme during the same time of admissions and the committee has the right to exceed the capacity of seats as and when necessary.

- 2.2 The course will be of 5 years duration in the integrated M.A. programme. There will be total ten (10) semesters from where the first six (6) semesters are of **Under Graduate** course and the rest four (4) semesters i.e. 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Semester, are **Post Graduate** course. The total marks for every semesters 500 in **Under Graduate** course and 400 marks every semester in **Post Graduate** Programme.
- 2.3 A student passing regularly the 6<sup>th</sup> Semester of IMS programme, without break in any mid semester, can leave the course for any types of higher studies (or Post Graduate programme) in outside the University. However the concerned student will have to inform the University authority accordingly before discontinuing at the PG level.
- 2.4 The student, who wants to leave the University, clearing 6<sup>th</sup> Semester Examinations without break, will be awarded Pass Certificate along with the Mark sheet of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester when necessary. The weight age of the Pass Certificate of passing 6<sup>th</sup> Semester will be equivalent to any other Graduation Certificate of any UGC recognised University.
- 2.5 The unsuccessful candidate will get the chance to clear the semester in the next odd/even semester examination accordingly.
- 2.6 The candidates passed out in 6<sup>th</sup> semester examination are eligible for admission into the 7<sup>th</sup> Semester with different specialisation bearing same enrolment number.

- 3.1 The applicant should be a regular passed out candidate from Higher School Leaving Certificate or equivalent examination conducted by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council or any other Board examination.
- 3.2 The applicant can get the admission on the basis of merit. There is no provision of employee quota in the University Admission System.
- 3.3 Just after the **Diksharambha Utsav**, the regular classes will be held on or before 1<sup>st</sup> week of August every year.
- 3.4 The admitted students must attend their classes not less than 75% in the whole semester. Otherwise he or she will be debarred from sitting in the examination hall.
- 3.5 **The University Authority has the right to withdraw or change the admission system as and when necessary.**
