Regulation - 1
Regulations for the Communicative Sanskrit
(Vanipravesha (वाणीप्रवेशः)

1. The course is compulsory for the Students of all the subjects excluding the those belonging to the school of Sanskrit Studies.
2. The course will be of 3 months duration and will commence from 1st Feb to 30th April of the 2nd Semester.
3. The total marks for the course will be of 200. There will be one Theory paper of 100 marks and one practical Paper of 100 marks. The pass mark of the theory paper will be 40 and for practical paper 50 marks.
4. A group discussion on the course will be held in the month of April.
5. The final Examination on the course will be held in the month of May and the result will be declared before the End semester examination
6. The unsuccessful candidates will get the chance to clear the subject during even Semester.
7. The course fees is Rs. 600/- (may be changed from time to time) However students who will appear in the examination as an arrear subject will have to pay Rs 200/- as examination fee at the time of filling up the examination form.
8. A separate Certificate will be awarded to the successful candidates.
