REGULATION ON-3

REGULATION ON CAMPUS AND ATTENDANCE IN CLASSES OF THE STUDENTS

- 1. All the courses of studies of the Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit & Ancient Studies University, Nalbari will run from the University Campus only.
- There is no off campus and branch offices of the university.
- 3. Students must have to attend at least 75 % of the classes held during a semester in all departments.
- 4. Students attending below 60 % of classes held in the department will not be allowed to appear in the next semester final examination.
- 5. Students attending classes below 75 % of the classes held in the department will have to pay a fee as decided by the University from time to time as non regular fee and will be treated as non regular students.
- 6. The Vice Chancellor may take for consideration of the special cases of students having attendance not as per requirement.
- 7. The qualifying marks for the internal assessment will be 50 % of the total marks allotted in a paper.
- 8. The internal assessment will be calculated on the basis of the two Sessional Examinations, Home assignment, Seminar/workshops/symposium etc as decided by the respective Department.
- 9. Students will be allowed to repeat one paper in one semester. The paper wherein the students secure 50 % of marks or above of the allotted marks will not be allowed to repeat. There is no provision for repeat of the practical papers. Students will have to pay examination fee for the Repeat/Back/Arrear paper as decided by the university authorities from time to time.

10. Any other matter arising beyond these will be decided by the concerned appropriate authorities of the University. Akting the sea of States of States
