**Regulation No. 8**

**Regulations on Five Year Integrated MA in Sanskrit (IMS)**

1. The Integrated MA Programme will be of 5(five) years duration (10 semesters), including 3 year B.A (Hons) and 2 year MA Programme.
2. B.A. (Hons) Degree will be awarded after successful completion of 6 semesters and M.A. Degree will be awarded after completion of remaining 4 semesters.
3. Students will be allowed to repeat 2(two) papers in one semester provided he/she gets less than 55% in the particular paper/ papers.
4. Students will be allowed to clear maximum of 2(two) arrear papers in each semester examinations.
5. The final results, i.e. B.A. (Hons) and MA will not be declared unless all the semester papers are successfully cleared.
6. After completion of 6 Semester, IMS students will be admitted to the 1<sup>ST</sup> semester M.A. (either Sanskrit Sahitya or Sanskrit Vedic Studies or any other programme(s) available) considering their preferences, earlier results and availability of seats.
7. Students having arrear in 6<sup>th</sup> or earlier semester will be allowed to take admission in M.A., 1<sup>ST</sup> semester. But their certificate of B.A.(Hons) course will be awarded only after clearing arrear papers.
8. Students who have not cleared some earlier semester will also be allowed to take admission in 1<sup>ST</sup> semester M.A.. But their certificate and final Mark Sheet of B.A. (Hons) course will be awarded only after clearing all the 6 semesters.
9. Students clearing the 6<sup>th</sup> semester will be allowed to repeat two papers in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semesters provided he/she
  - i. gets less than 55% of marks in the particular paper/papers. and
  - ii. passed the earlier semesters without arrearSuch students will have to surrender his/her final Mark Sheet and Certificate of B.A.(Hons) course.
10. In case of any other matter, the regulations of M.A. programmes will remain relevant in IMS also
