

#### Report on Observation of Gandhi Jayanti, 2023

The Department of Political Science, Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University, Nalbari, Assam has successfully organized four days long Programme to observe the Gandhi Jayanti from 29<sup>th</sup> September to 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2023. The Programme started on 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 with the welcome speech of the Coordinator of the Programme Mr. Ankur Jyoti Bhuyan. The programme was inaugurated by Honourable Vice Chancellor of the University Prof. Pralhad R. Joshi. In his inaugural address he basically highlighted the significant contribution of Mahatma Gandhi and his transformation from Mohan das karam chand gandhi to Mahatma Gandhi. He also stressed on 'swachhata' which was one of the prime agenda of Gandhiji. Gandhian principle of non-violence also has been deeply elaborated by the honourable Vice Chancellor. 














