

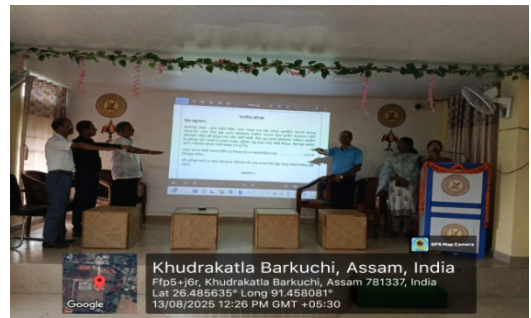
Report on the observance of Anti-Drug activities and taking e-Pledge against Drugs on 13th August, 2025

This report serves to document of the event of Anti-Drug initiative with taking e-pledge organized by the Nasa Mukta Hostel Committee at Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University, Nalbari, Assam on 13th August, 2025.
