



## **ADMISSION NOTIFICATION OF TWO YEARS MASTER OF LAWS (SELF FINANCED)**

Online applications are invited from intending and eligible candidates for admission to the Two Years **Master of Laws (LLM)** programme under School of Ancient Studies at Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University, Nalbari, for the Academic Session 2025-26.

Admission shall be made through an **Entrance Test**, which will be conducted on the **University campus**. The intake capacity of the programme is **40 seats**.

Out of 40 seats, 30 seats will be filled from the rank list of the entrance examination. The remaining 10 seats will be filled after the admission process based on the rank list is completed. The date of admission for these 10 seats will be announced separately. For admission to these 10 seats, which are excluded from the rank list, reservation norms will not be applicable.

Candidates must fill in and submit the online application through the **KBVSASU portal**, available on the University website:

### **ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FEE**

- ❖ Applicants are required to pay Rs. 800/- (Rupees Eight Hundred only) for appearing in the Entrance Test, exclusively through the Payment Gateway available on the admission portal at the time of submitting the online application form.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- ❖ The candidate must have completed a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) degree or an equivalent law degree from any recognized university/institution with minimum 50% marks in aggregate. There is a relaxation of 5% marks for OBC/SC/ST(P)/ST(H) candidates.

### **RESERVATION**

- ❖ The existing provisions of reservation shall be applicable as per Government of Assam rules.
- ❖ The caste certificate must be issued by the competent authority under the Government of Assam.
- ❖ UR-Economically Weaker Section (UR-EWS): The benefit of reservation under the EWS category may be availed upon production of a valid Income and Asset Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The number of EWS seats shall be determined based on the intake capacity of each department.
- ❖ Persons with Disabilities (PWD): There is a provision of 3% reservation for PWD candidates as per University rules. Candidates who are Visually Impaired and/or Hearing Impaired and/or Orthopedically Handicapped must submit a self-attested copy of the Disability Certificate issued

#### **ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FEE**

- ❖ Applicants are required to pay Rs. 800/- (Rupees Eight Hundred only) for appearing in the Entrance Test, exclusively through the Payment Gateway available on the admission portal at the time of submitting the online application form.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- ❖ The candidate must have completed a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) degree or an equivalent law degree from any recognized university/institution with minimum 50% marks in aggregate. There is a relaxation of 5% marks for OBC/SC/ST(P)/ST(H) candidates.

#### **RESERVATION**

- ❖ The existing provisions of reservation shall be applicable as per Government of Assam rules.
- ❖ The caste certificate must be issued by the competent authority under the Government of Assam.
- ❖ UR-Economically Weaker Section (UR-EWS): The benefit of reservation under the EWS category may be availed upon production of a valid Income and Asset Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The number of EWS seats shall be determined based on the intake capacity of each department.
- ❖ Persons with Disabilities (PWD): There is a provision of 3% reservation for PWD candidates as per University rules. Candidates who are Visually Impaired and/or Hearing Impaired and/or Orthopedically Handicapped must submit a self-attested copy of the Disability Certificate issued

by the District Chief Medical Officer / Medical Board. The benefit of reservation shall be applicable only to candidates having at least 40% permanent physical disability, and the percentage of disability must be clearly mentioned in the certificate.

#### CANCELLATION OF SEATS

A student who fails to attend classes for fifteen (15) consecutive days from the date of commencement of classes shall forfeit his/her seat.

#### ATTENDANCE

A minimum of 75% class attendance is mandatory for appearing in all end-semester examinations.

#### ADMISSION FEE

- ❖ Students admitted on merit : Rs. 40,000.00 (Rupees Forty Thousand Only) per annum.
- ❖ Students admitted from open list : Rs. 70,000.00 (Rupees Seventy Thousand Only) per annum
- ❖ The fee will be collected in two equal installments.

#### PATTERN OF ENTRANCE TEST

- Mode of Examination: Offline
- Type of Questions: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)
- Total Number of Questions: 100
- Total Marks: 100
- Time: 2 Hours
- Marking Scheme: Each question shall carry one (1) mark. There is no negative marking.

- ❖ Applicants are required to upload the following documents:

  - c) HSLC Admit Card/Certificate and Marksheets
  - d) HSSLC/HS Certificate and Marksheets
  - e) UG Marksheets
  - f) Caste/Category Certificate (if applicable)
- ❖ Applicants are advised to apply well in advance of the last date of submission to avoid any last-minute technical issues.
- ❖ Mere submission of the application form does not guarantee admission. Admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, as per University rules.


#### GUIDELINES FOR SCANNING AND UPLOADING DOCUMENTS

Before applying, candidates are required to keep scanned (digital) copies of their photograph, signature, and relevant documents ready, as per the specifications given below:

- 1) Photograph (Selfies are not allowed)
  - Recent passport-size colour photograph
  - File size: 20 KB to 100 KB
  - Format: jpg / jpeg
- 2) Signature
  - File size: 10 KB to 50 KB
  - Format: jpg / jpeg
- 3) Documents
  - Scanned copies of documents must be in PDF format
  - Maximum file size: 500 KB or below

- In case the photograph, signature, or uploaded documents are unclear or illegible, the candidate's application may be rejected.
- Upon successful completion of the application process, candidates will receive a system-generated acknowledgement, which should be printed and retained for future reference.
