Spot Admission to the Master of Laws (LLM) in Ancient Indian Jurisprudence

Applications are invited for Spot Admission to the Master of Laws (LL.M.) in Ancient Indian Jurisprudence for the Academic Session 2026-27.

Candidates who have appeared in the final semester/year examination of the qualifying degree but whose result has not yet been declared may also participate in the Spot Admission process subject to the following conditions:

1. Candidates must have appeared in the final semester/year examination of the qualifying examination before participating in the Spot Admission process.
2. Such candidates shall be granted provisional admission, subject to the submission/verification of their qualifying examination result when declared.
3. The candidate must successfully clear the qualifying examination to continue their studies in the University. Candidates whose qualifying examination result is awaited shall be required to submit the result/mark sheet to the University immediately after its declaration. If the candidate fails to clear the qualifying examination, the provisional admission shall stand cancelled.
4. The admission fee once paid shall not be refunded in the event of cancellation of admission due to failure to clear the qualifying examination or for any other reason.
5. Participation in the Spot Admission process or provisional admission shall not be construed as confirmation of eligibility unless the candidate fulfils all the prescribed eligibility criteria of the University.

All candidates are advised to carefully read and understand the above conditions before participating in the Spot Admission process. The detailed procedure, schedule, and other relevant information regarding Spot Admission have already been notified separately. Candidates are requested to refer to the Spot Admission Notice for detailed information and guidelines regarding the admission process.
